

## QMS Review Committee Sensitizes College Staffs on Key Changes

Among the newly introduced changes in the University's Quality Management System were reviewing and implementing academic programmes in compliance with established policy and regulations, offering services to the university's customers in relation to the service charter, ensuring utilization of university resources in compliance within budgetary levels and increasing the number of academic publications in refereed journals by at least 150 annually among others.
